

Exhibition on life of C V Raman

» An exhibition to commemorate the life and achievements of Noble Laureate Sir C V Raman was inaugurated at Indian Institute of Science (IISc), on Wednesday, by Raman's daughter-in-law, **Dominique Radhakrishnan**.

Titled, "Celebrating the life of a Rare Gem", the exhibition has on display a number of archival photographs, documents and memorabilia related to the life of the eminent scientist. One of the memorabilia is the original appointment order making C V Raman, first Indian director of IISc in 1932.

The order shows Raman was sanctioned salary of Rs 3,000 as director and Professor of the institute. Also on display is the original working model of Raman's spectrometer and letter of correspondence by staff of IISc at that time to its director C V Raman. The exhibition is on till March 13 and will showcase a documentary on Raman.
